

Six Senses Spa at Evason Hideaway Yao Noi

Six Senses' Hub, Bangkok, August 2007: The Evason Hideaway at Yao Noi, opening on October 01 2007, will feature a unique Six Senses Spa styled along the lines of a traditional Asian long-house. The spa is constructed of natural materials which compliment the tropically-forested hillside location.

The Six Senses Spa offers lifestyle consultations and programmes tailored to guest's individual requirements and offers a comprehensive range of signature therapies such as Swedish and Holistic pampering massages. It offers the unique Six Senses Massage Fusion, in addition to a complete range of treatments for men, and romantic massages for couples under star-filled evening skies - creating rejuvenating sensory spa journeys.

The spa's signature area is the long-house suite, which represents a classic village house typically found in northern Thailand. The entire long-house is made of wood, creating a journey through four different treatment areas. The treatments offered have a Thai emphasis – ranging from body and beauty care to traditional Thai treatments, and use Thai herbs from the spa's own herb gardens. The design also allows for each treatment area to be used for individual treatments.

In addition to the four major long-house treatment rooms, there are several indoor and outdoor fully self-contained treatment suites. Boardwalks link to three salas which are elevated over a large pond. There is also a steam and sauna suite allowing guests to experience a variety of wet treatments including bucket bath, plunge pool, rain shower, sauna and steam. Other facilities include an oval shaped yoga sala, a fifty-square meter gym, private consultation area, spa shop, juice bar and relaxation areas.

Whether it is a traditional Thai long-house spa journey or a signature treatment, the team of highly trained international therapists ensures each therapy delivers a positive impact to the guest's wellbeing.

The Evason Hideaway at Yao Noi consists of 56 Pool Villas and Pool Villa Suites, the three-bedroom Hilltop Reserve and the two-bedroom Retreat – both with private pools. Several villas offer spa suites with separate outdoor spa salas, accommodating double or individual treatments, while the Reserve comes with a full spa. The natural vegetation and tropical landscaping, provides privacy between the elevated villas and allow glorious views over Phang Nga Bay.

The island of Yao Noi is a forty-minute powerboat trip from Phuket's Ao Po Pier. Commencing in March 2008, a ten-minute helicopter transfer will be offered.
